Purpose of Report

1.0 STEM Subject Performance

The overall performance in STEM subjects indicates that **Lebang**, **Mihingo**, and **Justice** performed extremely well.

- Three learners achieved marks below 50%: **Alice**, **Okuhle**, and **Madimedja**.

Analysis of Other Subjects:

- **Distinctions:** 2 learners achieved distinctions in Sepedi, 1 in Zulu, and 3 in History.
- **Areas of Concern:** 3 learners scored below 50% in these subjects, with **Madimedja** receiving the lowest score of 33%.

3.0 Subject-Specific Analysis

- **Mathematics:** The best performance was by **Justice** (75%), while **Alice** had the lowest score (41%). Two learners (**Alice** and **Okuhle**) scored below 50%. The average score was 56%.
- **Life Sciences:** **Lebang** achieved the highest mark (75%). The overall performance is satisfactory, with only one learner scoring below 50%.
- **Physical Science:** **Mihingo** had the highest score (67%), while **Nombulelo** had the lowest (48%). The average score is 55%. Teachers have suggested acquiring apparatus and solutions for practical experiments to improve grades in this subject.

4.0 Individual Learner Analysis

- **Nombulelo:** Excellent English performance. Strong in languages.
- **Justice:** Strong overall performance, especially in Mathematics and Physical Sciences. Suitable for STEM pathways.
- **Lebang:** Good balance across subjects, particularly Life Sciences.
- **Mihingo:** Outstanding all-round performance. Strong candidate for science and health-related careers.
- **Safouratou:** Very strong English and Life Sciences performance.
- **Alice:** Good language skills but satisfactory Mathematics and Physical Sciences.
- **Kwandiswa:** Average performance across subjects.
- **Okuhle:** Excellent English mark but satisfactory in other subjects.
